Board Policy on Smoking

General Rule:

The Board recognized that the use of tobacco by anyone presents a health and safety hazard which can have serious consequence for both users and nonusers.

Definition:

For the purpose of this policy, tobacco shall be defined as lighted cigarette, cigar and pipe; or any other lighted smoking products.

Rationale:

In order to protect the safety of, and set a good example for, the children in our program, we cannot allow the usage of lighted tobacco in any form in any Ridley JR ABA managed property. The Board is committed to the improving the overall ABA experience for all children and tobacco has no place at any ABA event at which BYC children are in attendance.
